A GREAT RECIPE

PINEAPPLE GREEK YOGURT ICE CREAM

Ingredients:

- 2 cups frozen pineapple chunks
- 1/2 cup unsweetened almond milk
- 1/2 cup non-fat Greek yogurt
- 1 tablespoon honey or your favorite sugar substitute (optional)
- 1/2 teaspoon vanilla extract

Directions:

Step 1: Blend The Ingredients

- In a blender or food processor, combine the frozen pineapple chunks, unsweetened almond milk, non-fat Greek yogurt, honey (if using), and vanilla extract.

Step 2: Process Until Smooth

- Blend the mixture until it reaches a smooth and creamy consistency. You may need to stop and scrape down the sides of the blender or processor to ensure everything is well combined.

Step 3: Serve Immediately

- Once blended, serve the ice cream immediately for a softserve texture. If you prefer a firmer ice cream, transfer the mixture to an airtight container and freeze for about 1-2 hours before serving.

Step 4: Enjoy

- Scoop into bowls and enjoy your homemade pineapple Greek yogurt ice cream!


Mother's Day was originally a protest against war.

Social activist, Julia Ward Howe, introduced Mother's Day to the United States following the Civil War. But her concept of the holiday was different from the one we know today. Howe's vision of Mother's Day was a day dedicated to promoting peace, where women would rally against war. Some people continued to celebrate the holiday as a means of protest, one of them being a group of women who rallied against nuclear weapons in 1982.
